Call to Order

Jill Arendell called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

Roll Call

Approval of Minutes

Alaina Jones presented the minutes of the meeting from October 12, 2018 for approval. The minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurers Report

Current bank balance is \$44,201.24. Total income for October was \$26,960.258. \$20,521.57 of that was from Laps for Longhorns. We are currently waiting on the final deposits from Boosterthon. We also received the \$314.04 check from our Chick-Fil-A family fun night in September. We incurred \$1,195.18 in expenses. \$983.20 was for a Staff Appreciation Luncheon that was held on October 24th. The PTA was also able to pay out \$7,883.85 in teacher/school requests.
