Call to Order

Jill Arendell called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

Roll Call

Board members in attendance are Jill Arendell, Amanda Melancon, Kate Kelly, Melissa Bowman and Alaina Jones.

Approval of Minutes

Alaina Jones presented the minutes of the meeting from January 11, 2019 for approval. The minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report

Talent Show Review: Total Income \$3,950 (Ticket Sales \$1550, Art Show \$2132, Concession \$268) and Total Expenses were \$1924.98 (Custodian \$100, Concession \$289.47, Artome \$1377, Square Fee \$53.51, Cindy Hong \$105). This resulted in a total profit of \$2,025.02.

The school was only charged by Artome for the pieces of artwork that sold. (81) pieces of artwork sold. Mrs. Hong will be receiving the artwork that did not sell and it will be available for purchase at \$5/each.

Other income for the month was: Giving Tree Donation \$1400 ((4) teachers received \$125/each, (2) received \$200/each and the school was able to purchase (3) additional Chromebooks), Amazon Smiles \$7.63, Laps for Longhorns \$182 and Spiritwear \$152.

Other expenses for the month were: Chick-Fil-A (teacher luncheon) \$1239.75 and (3) Chromebooks \$608.31.

Yearbook
